

The Eken Park Merger Committee proposes that the Eken Park Neighborhood Association (EPNA) shall be dissolved and that the Eken Park Neighborhood Association and the Emerson East Neighborhood Association (EENA) merge into a single entity, the Eken Park Emerson East Neighborhood Association (EPEENA).

This new neighborhood association will include all of the territorial boundaries of the two neighborhood associations.

The EPNA and EENA will close their bank accounts and will deposit their assets into a new account owned by the newly formed EPEENA, which will serve as the primary account for the new neighborhood association.

The dissolution and merger will become effective on November 1, 2023.

For a period of one year, from November 1, 2023 to November 1, 2024, one co-chair will be chosen from the Eken Park neighborhood and one co-chair will be chosen from the Emerson East neighborhood.

The EPNA and EENA merged bylaws and any additional details, including financial obligations pertaining to the merger will be discussed by the officers and presented to the members prior to the formation of the EPEENA.
